Artist Selection Process

More than 700 applications were received for the 150 booths at the 2010 Art Fair. Each artist submitted images of their work and examples of their booth installation. Artists were chosen on the basis of the work's originality, technical execution, and innovation. Laumeier Art Fair artists have a reputation for quality and creativity.

Awards

Cash prizes totaling \$11,000 will be awarded on Saturday, May 8 to those artists judged the best overall. Judges from the St. Louis art community will award a total of 18 prizes, including the ArtMart award which is given to two outstanding local artists. Award winners will have ribbons posted on their booths. Each winner is invited to return for the 2011 Art Fair. This year we have 10 returning award winners.

Art Fair Image

St. Louis designer Cheree Berry created this year's Art Fair image.
