### Student Art Showcase

The Laumeier Student Ambassadors will present the fifth annual Student Art Showcase to highlight the work of student artists from area colleges and universities. Students from each of the participating schools will have an opportunity to have their work seen by more than 14,000 people who will visit Laumeier for the Mother's Day weekend event.

Artists' work will be selected by a jury composed of the Laumeier Student Ambassadors and Laumeier staff. Applicants must be enrolled students at one of the participating schools. Artwork in a variety of mediums may be submitted. All submissions will be handled electronically and must be **submitted at [www.zapplication.org](http://www.zapplication.org) by January 20, 2010**. By utilizing this service, students will gain valuable experience with the same process used by thousands of artists who pursue their art careers on the fair circuit. Artists must submit five digital photos of up to five different works. All work considered must be original and complete and available for preparation and display May 3-May 11, 2010. Artists are not required, but encouraged to be present during Art Fair. **No work can be sold at the event**, however, artist contact information will be available for distribution.

Artwork will be displayed during regular ArtFair hours and securely stored when not displayed. Artwork will need to be **delivered to Laumeier on Monday, May 3 and picked-up by Tuesday, May 11**.

### **Media:**

Artwork must be classified in one category: clay, fiber, glass, wood, jewelry, mixed-media, painting, photography, printmaking/drawing, digital, or sculpture/metals.

### **Eligibility:**

Applicants must be enrolled students at one of the participating schools: SIU-Edwardsville, Saint Louis University, Washington University or Webster University.

### **Rules:**

1. All work must be hand-made originals
2. All hanging work must be suitably framed
3. All artwork must be available for display May 3-May 11, 2010
4. No work will be available for sale at the event
5. The jury committee reserves the right to refuse exhibition of work that is not consistent with submitted images and the rules listed above

### **Instructions:**

1. All submissions will be handled through our online application partner.
2. Create a free account at [www.zapplication.org](http://www.zapplication.org). Enter your school for the "Business or Studio" name
3. Prepare five digital images of your work as specified by the instructions at [www.zapplication.org/imaging\\_tips.phtml](http://www.zapplication.org/imaging_tips.phtml).
4. Submit your photos and click the "apply to shows" tab. Scroll to Art Fair at Laumeier 2010 and click "view more info". **The application and exhibition space fees will be waived for the Student Art Showcase.**
5. Review the show info and click "apply to this show." Read and accept the agreement.
6. Choose "Student Showcase" for your category, select your images (including one image tagged as your booth shot) and save the application.
7. On the checkout tab, check the \$35 application fee and the "re-calculate" button. On the subsequent screen, enter coupon code "**student**" to deduct the application fees and be considered for the Student Art Showcase. Click the "re-calculate" button, then the "proceed to checkout" button and finally the "submit application" button.
8. **Electronic applications must be submitted by midnight, Wednesday, January 20, 2010.**
